

LIFELINE CONNECTIONS
Sliding Fee Scale for IOP/OP Services

Qualification for services is based on need, not on ability to pay, and will be determined based on available resources and at the sole discretion of Lifeline management.

Medicaid recipients receive medically-necessary services without charge and without delays in admission.

Persons with insurance with alcohol and drug benefits will be served according to their specific health insurance plan.
