NEW BUSINESS

Program Review: Ashley presented the Sobering Unit Board report to the Advisory Board. Most referrals have been walk-ins, at 98%. There were 2,023 total admissions for this quarter, with 312 unduplicated patients. 58 individuals have stayed over ten times in the unit, the majority only staying less than four. The primary drug of choice has been alcohol and stimulants. On the next report, a highlight of the unit's demographic trends will be added.

Victoria shared patient stories of individuals who have utilized the inpatient programs, and the successes they have had in ongoing treatment.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

SURV Update: The van has been out for approximately a month and a half, doing a lot of outreach. They are bringing in 1-2 individuals to the unit each time. We are currently interviewing for a Recovery Coach for the van.

OTHER DISCUSSION

Kathy noted that it would be a great resource for Lifeline to begin working with the new Recovery Café down on Fourth Plain. Victoria will be reaching out to set up a meeting with them. October 27th will be the Medication Take Back event, at multiple locations. The flyer will be sent out for distribution. Victoria noted that the Sobering unit is in need of socks for the patients, as the weather is getting colder.
